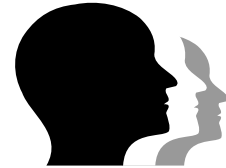

Respect for Others

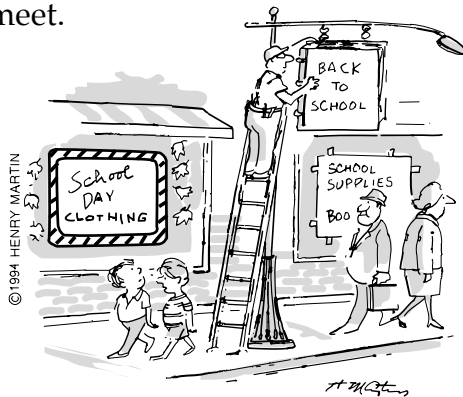
